

***FACT SHEET REGARDING HANSON COUNTY \$500,000 TEN YEAR
OPT-OUT***

- FACT:** All property owners in Hanson County will pay equally--
\$0.75/\$1000 of property evaluation.
- FACT:** Hanson County has 75 miles of asphalt roads. Presently all but 19
miles need either chip sealing or overlay.
- FACT:** There is approximately 14 miles in need of grinding and overlay
at an estimated cost of \$164,000/mile = \$2,296,000.
- FACT:** There is approximately 38 miles in need of chip-seal at a cost
estimate of \$25,000/mile = \$950,000.
- FACT:** Traffic counters are presently being run on all Hanson County
Asphalt roads.
- FACT:** We do have a 5-10 yr. plan for road maintenance and resurfacing
- FACT:** Hanson County personnel did a gravel depth survey of every mile
in Hanson County. The average depth on the shoulders = less
than 1" and on the center line less than 2".
- FACT:** There are 160 mile of gravel roads in Hanson County. To place a
3" depth would take 192,000 ton of gravel at estimated \$10.00/ton
(gravel and haul) = \$1,920,000.
- FACT:** Above facts does not include cost of general maintenance of
roads (blading etc.), snow removal or bridge repair/replacement.
- FACT:** This proposed \$500,000 opt-out will be used for roads and
bridges ONLY.
