ORDINANCE #17

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING OVERWEIGHT LOAD PERMITS

Pursuant to SDCL 32-14-6 be it ordained:

The Hanson County Commissioners authorize the Hanson County Superintendent of Highways to issue overweight county road permits under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. That the office of the Hanson County Highway Superintendent shall issue overweight permits only during the "frost season" as defined by the office of the Hanson County Highway Superintendent.
- 2. That in no event may such permit authorize transportation of loads that would exceed weight limits in place on county roads during the balance of the year.
- 3. That permits shall issue to the applicants but may be used by the applicant or his designee.
- 4. That permits shall issue for a designated and maximum 10 day period of overweight operation.
- 5. That permits shall be issued for a fee in advance in the amount of \$20.00.
- 6. That permits shall allow only for the transportation of loads which originate in or are destined for Hanson County, South Dakota, locations.
- 7 That transport of overweight loads authorized herein shall be undertaken only on county highways as designated on the issued permit.
- 8. That the issued permit or a copy thereof must be in the possession of utilizers during all periods of operation.
- 9. That the office of the Hanson County Highway Superintendent shall upon issuance of a permit, provide a copy of the same to the office of the Hanson County Sheriff forthwith.
- 10. That transportation of overweight loads without a permit is punishable by a fine of \$200.00 per incident per day in addition to any other civil or other criminal penalties.
