ORDINANCE # 24

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND HANSON COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE #18 REPEALING SECTION 523 #6 TO REMOVE THE MILEAGE LIMITS ON HAULING ANIMAL WASTE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hanson County, SD, that:

1. Ordinance No. 18 shall be amended by removing a paragraph; Section 523, Subparagraph 6.

3. Severability Provision. If any provision of this ordinance is declare unconstitutional or the applicability thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the constitutionality of the remainder of the ordinance and applicability thereof to others persons and circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
