ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HANSON COUNTY ORDINANCE 92 – 001 TO INCREASE THE 911 SURCHARGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hanson County, South Dakota, that Hanson County ordinance 92 – 001 be amended as follows:

- [1] that Section Two thereof to increase the uniform monthly 911 emergency surcharge from \$.75 per line to \$1.25 per line per month.
- [2] <u>Repealer</u>. Any and all ordinances, or portions of Ordinances, which are in conflict with the provisions hereof, are hereby repealed.

Justification for Ordinance:

- [a] it is necessary to increase the rates assessed for 911 services and related items in order to continue to provide this service to the citizens and residents of Hanson County, South Dakota;
- [b] this ordinance is necessary to amend the previous ordinance setting rates charged to effect that increase; and
- [c] it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and residents of Hanson County, South Dakota, to continue to have this service available.
