

HANSON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS
Tuesday, May 24, 2022

Commissioner Fox called the meeting of the Hanson County Drainage Board to order on Tuesday, May 24, 2022 with members Bumgardner, Kjetland, Schoenrock and Waldera present.

Motion Kjetland, seconded by Waldera to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion Schoenrock, seconded by Bumgardner to approve the May 10th meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Chairman Fox called to order the Hanson County drainage hearing and stated that the hearing was being held to remedy the improper drainage done in the county right of way on 247th St. in section 13-104-59.

All hearing attendees signed in and took an oath. A list of attendees can be viewed in the Auditor's office.

Testimony was presented by Justin Friese, Hwy Superintendent, on the current condition of the county right of way on 247th St. and his idea on how to best repair it. Duane Schultz voiced his concern about the ditches present condition and the need to have the ditch fixed for safety reasons. Tom Bannwarth presented his testimony and agreed that there is a need to come up with a resolution to fix the ditch.

After all questions and concerns from the audience were addressed, the hearing was closed. Motion Waldera, seconded by Kjetland to approve and set the following decisions to remedy the issue: Install not less than 18" drain tile, 1500' long, in the north ditch of 247th St. in section 13-04-59 with an engineer confirming the correct grade and capacity of the tile; fill and improve the grade and restore it to its original height and slope running both east and west in the north ditch for the length specified; use sufficient black dirt to reseed area and mulch; have all work completed, report made and a statement of completion given by July 5, 2022. All members voted aye, motion carried.

Davies will send out the written decision to all involved and the Hwy Superintendent will take before and after pictures of the area in concern.

Hearing adjourned.

As there was no further business before the Board, a motion was made by Bumgardner, seconded by Schoenrock to adjourn meeting. All voted aye, motion carried.
